The 3rd K-J JCCHN invites all interested individuals to submit a scientific abstract for oral, poster presentation. All conference abstracts must be submitted online via (http://kjjcchn.or.kr) no later than February 29, 2016

Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Academic Committee, and the presentation type can possibly be changed

by the review of the Academic Committee.

Abstract submission does not constitute registration for the conference and presenters are required to register for the conference separately.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Please use online abstract submission system through congress website (http://kjjcchn.or.kr) according to the submission formats. Abstracts sent in by fax or mail will not be accepted.

It is authors' responsibility to review the abstracts and correct them. Submitters are responsible for every typing error on the abstract. Abstracts will be published as submitted; i.e. any error appearing in the submitted abstract will appear in the published abstract book.

Please follow these guidelines carefully. Failure to comply with the guidelines will prevent the abstract from being considered for presentation at the congress.

- 1. All abstract submissions and presentations must be written in correct form of English.
- 2. The abstract document must be in MS WORD (*.doc) format.
- 3. Abstracts must describe original and previously unpublished work.
- 4. Abstracts should demonstrate a clear relationship to/with the conference themes:
- · Theoretical building in community health nursing
- · Evidence-based nursing
- · Population health and epidemiology
- · Community based participatory research/ Social network and support
- · Public health nursing service & administration/ Health program evaluation
- · Disaster preparedness/ Injury prevention
- · Transcultural nursing/ Faith community health nursing/ Rural health nursing
- · Child and adolescent health/ School health nursing
- · Health disparities/ Women's health
- · Occupational health nursing
- · Aging and health/ Long term care & caregiving/ Home health care nursing
- 5. The abstracts should be no longer than 250 words. Word count only includes text body of your abstract.

- 6. Abstracts should include Title, Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- 7. Abstract titles should be brief and reflecting the content of the abstract.
- 8. Tables and images are not permitted.
- 9. Submission must include all authors' names and primary academic/institutional affiliation only, and contact details of the corresponding author.
- 10. You can save and re-edit your abstracts online until you decide to submit them via the abstract system.
- 11. When submitting the finalized version of your abstract, please fill all required fields in the online system.
- 12. Corresponding authors will automatically receive an e-mail confirming the acceptance of his/her abstract.
- 13. Abstract submission does not constitute registration for the congress and presenters are required to register for the congress separately.
- 14. The same presenting author (oral or poster) cannot be assigned to more than 3 abstracts but can be included as co-author on many abstracts.
